

Neonatology

Congratulations on the birth of your child! It was born prematurely. Many parents experience premature births as highly stressful and connected to great concern regarding the further development of their child.

Fortunately, most premature babies will develop inconspicuously in spite of their difficult starting conditions.

However, some children and many parents need support even after the initial hospital discharge. This is where our offering can help. We can support the development of your child and of you as parents, discuss questions regarding child development, talk about your observations, and accompany you as parents just as you wish, starting in the hospital and continuing at home.

Target groups

This offering is available to all parents from the canton of Solothurn whose child was born before the 32nd week of pregnancy and/or had a birth weight of less than 1,500 grams. Stiftung Arkadis Olten is supported by the Bachtelen curative education service in Solothurn and the ZKSK in Oensingen in the project.

- Support for affected children and their parents before, during and after discharge from hospital
- \cdot Support for parents with questions about their child's development
- Support for parents in recognizing and interpreting behavioural situations of their child
- \cdot Procurement and provision of information

Procedure

- Contact during the hospital stay
- Talks in the hospital and/or at home
- Home visits
- Exchange of information (in person, on the phone, in writing)
- · Accompaniment to meetings with doctors, nurses or other specialists

Costs
